VOLONTÉ CZECH, o.p.s. and involved stakeholders (Czech prisons - Jirice, Kynsperk, Hradec Kralove, Svetla nad Sazavou, Vsehrdy, Apenhet AS Company from Norway, Personnel and Education agency DP WORK, Probation and Mediation Service, General Directorate of Prison Service, The Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, General Directorate of the Employment Department, etc.) respond to the stagnant recidivism and to the unresolved issue of a smooth transition of clients from imprisonment into everyday life. We propose a mentoring program for a pilot group of 150 clients from 5 prisons.

Due to the personal meetings with prisons, we created personal, organizational, technical and financial preconditions for the implementation of the program, which we plan to implement within the interconnected key activities. The main aim of the project is to create appropriate and complex conditions for resocialization and reintegration of clients and support them in the positive way of their development and fight recidivism. The target group consists of 12 mentors and 150 prisoners. We believe that the project will contribute to the creation of appropriate conditions for the resocialization of people after release. Thanks to the interconnection of the activities of state institutions and NPO, the continuity and complexity of services in the area of prevention will be achieved. A qualified approach of professionals and trained mentors will support the client in positive changes in his life and thus reduce the risk of recidivism.
